Yes, the sensor itself is in the tank, but it has accessible contacts outside the tank (basically, where the components that take the signal to the gauge attach to the top of the sensor unit, which itself is inside of the tank  $\hat{a} \square \square$  essentially, the interface between the inside of the tank and the outside world.) It $\hat{a} \square \square$  s these contacts that  $|\hat{a} \square \square|$  ve seen can be cleaned with some effect.
