| I recently purchased (on eBay) a Porsche 9201 Timing Belt tool to check my timing belt. It came with the calibration bar and when I check it, it reads approximately 3.7 which is in the lower limits of acceptable (4.0 +/- 0.3).                          |
| The factory manual tells you who to adjust to calibration with a small screw driver. However, I do not seem to find a slotted screw like I expected. I used an otoscope (ear exam tool) to look into the adjustment hole, and I do not see a slotted screw! |
| If anyone has experienced using the 9201 gauge and have they ever attempted to readjust the calibration?  |
| Also, has anyone ever sent their gauge back to the supplier to be re-calibrated?  |
