There are two schools of thought on this - the math approach that Joe takes above, or trial and error. If you weld a tab onto the end of the T-bar, and especially if you have access to a lift, trial and error is pretty quick. Lift tire up, insert T-bar, set car down. If too high or low, lift car up, pull out T-bar a couple of inches to disengage. Lift up a little higher (or lower) on the wheel as you slide back in and re-engage T-bar. Repeat until close, then use blades for fine adjustment. No need to drop the rear suspension to do this.

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
